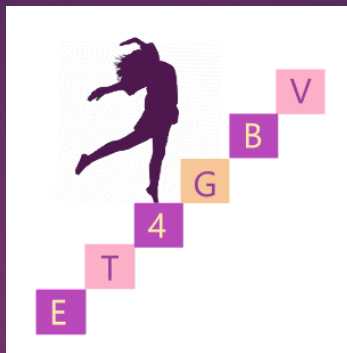

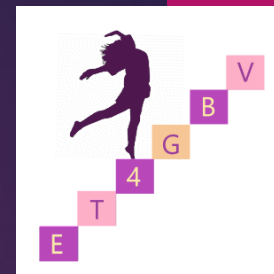

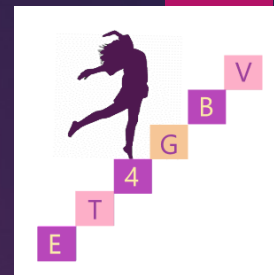

# 1. Multiplier Event



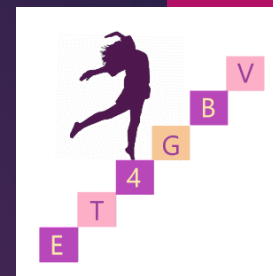
Successfully carried out the 3 multiplying events of the project in each country.

The assessment before the event was very positive by the majority.



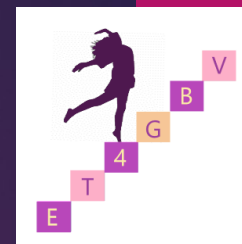




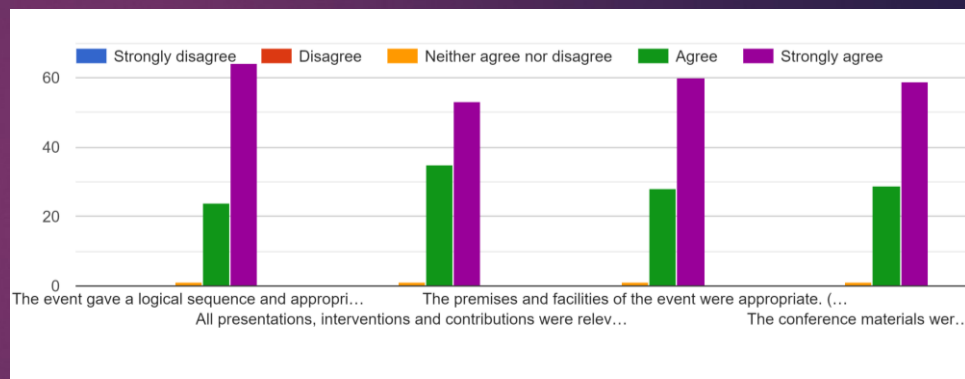

4. The conference materials were relevant and informative.

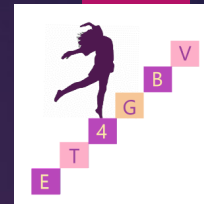


The four points were mostly quite favorable, the second point is a little below average, but generally very well valued.

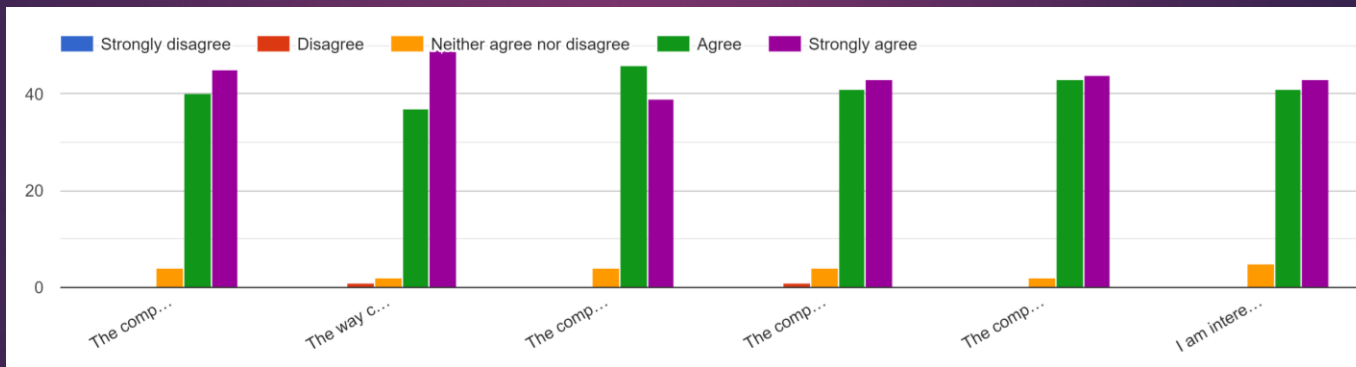

Highly valued the Competence matrix with the same number of votes in the two highest ratings. The “way are created and presented is effective and understandable” is the best valued of the product.





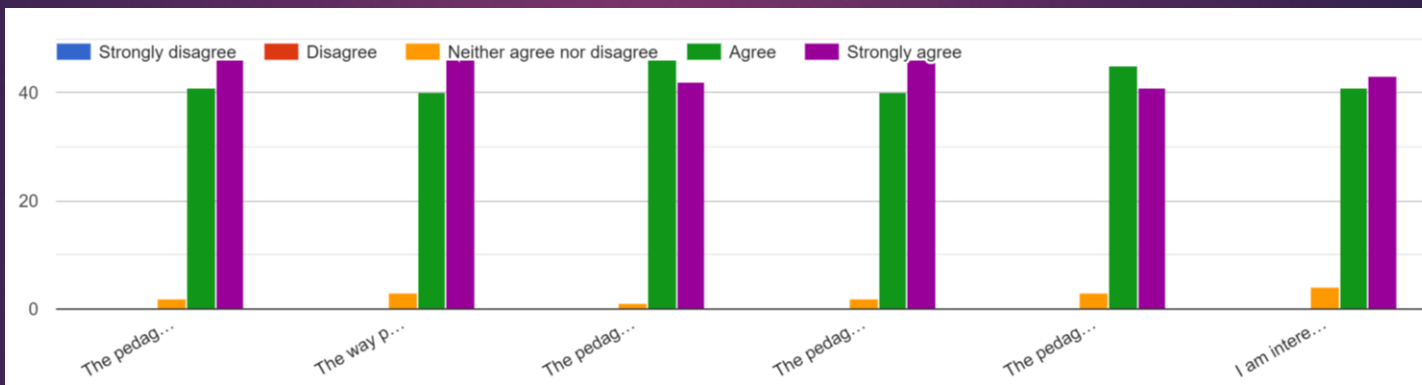

Highly valued the pedagogical guide with the same number of votes in the two highest ratings.





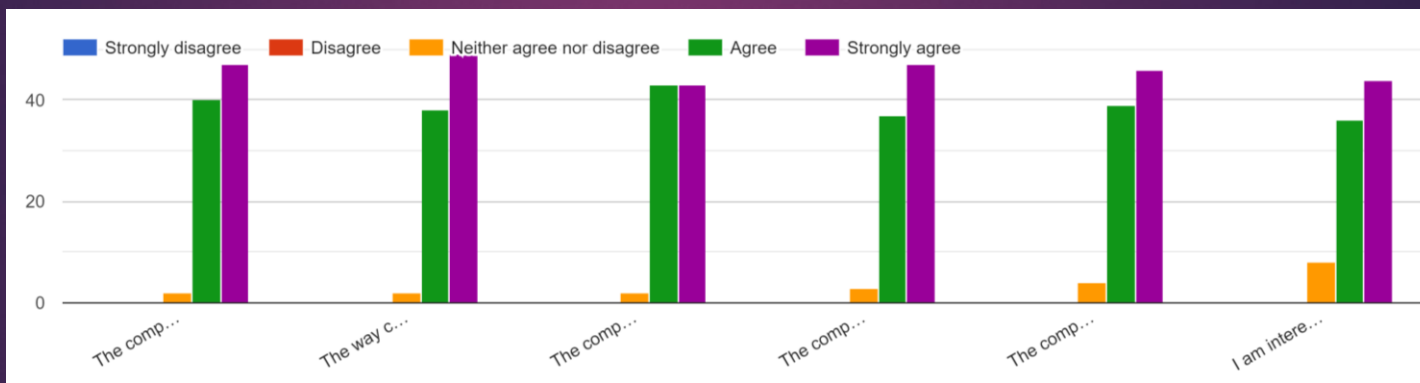

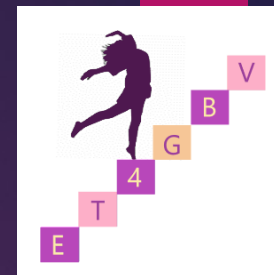
The Companies guide has been the best rated of the three products, with the highest number of votes in the best rating.

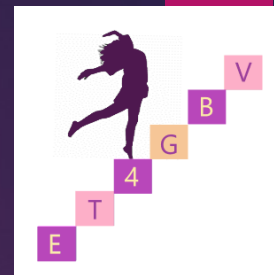
